



SULTAN'S VILLAGE RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The Sultan's Village Kids' Club is available on a complimentary basis to all guests aged 4 to 11 years old.
2. Daily themed activities are organised for three different age groups: 4 to 5 years old, 6 to 8 years old and 9 to 11 years old (number of children permitting).
3. Children under 4 years old must be accompanied by an adult or guardian. Babysitting services are available at a charge.
4. Older children can access Amilla Fushi's Teens' Club, located at the water sports beach. The Teens' Club organises activities appropriate for teens and children aged 12 and above.
5. The Sultan's Village is open year-round on a daily basis according to posted hours. Maximum capacity is 40 children.
6. Children must be registered for activities by an adult. Registration can be completed any time of day but we recommend mornings or early afternoons to avoid disappointment.
7. Participation in activities requires parent or guardian's registration for the child \ and adherence to the internal rules and regulations of the club.
8. Parents must disclose any allergies, sensitivities or health issues when registering their children for activities.
9. Children with minor illnesses must obtain clearance from the resort doctor before joining in the club's activities.
10. The Sultan's Village staff are not permitted to administer medication to children.
11. Children are not permitted to leave the kids' club unattended, unless formally specified by parents (children over 9 years old only). Otherwise, all children must be signed out by an adult.
12. Activities are subject to change depending on weather conditions and unforeseen circumstances.
13. Children are invited to participate in group activities designed for their age group, as proposed in the advertised programme and requested to arrive 10 minutes before the scheduled activity.
14. Children must bring a hat or cap, sunscreen, a swimming suit and a change of clothes. Floatation bands or swimming rings are required for children who cannot swim.
15. We advise against bringing valuable items (such as electronic devices and jewelries) to the Sultan's Village. The hotel will not be held responsible if these items are lost or damaged.
16. The Sultan's Village aims to bring joy and enrichment to children through games, activities and discovery. Hosts and hostesses do not take any disciplinary action. In the event that one or more children repeatedly engage in disruptive behaviour, they will be escorted back to their parents.
17. For the sake of children with allergies, food of any kind is strictly prohibited in The Sultan's Village.
18. Parents may choose to purchase lunch or dinner for their child when registering them for The Sultan's Village.
19. In the event parents are absent for a prolonged period or beyond normal hours, The Sultan's Village team is authorised to take any measures necessary to ensure the child's wellbeing.
